Title:	IRIS Toxicological Review of Trimethylbenzenes (Revised External Review Draft)
Purpose/Objective:	EPA is reassessing its IRIS toxicological review of Trimethylbenzenes (1,2,3-;1,2,4-;1,3,5-). This trimethylbenzene reassessment consists of an oral reference dose (RfD), an inhalation reference concentration (RfC), an inhalation unit risk (IUR) and a cancer weight of evidence descriptor. This is the first assessment developing an RfC or IUR for this compound. This assessment is intended to provide human health data to support agency regulatory decisions.
