The derivation of the overall oral reference dose (RfD) based on nervous system effects (specifically convulsions) seems appropriate. Likewise, the derivation of the oral slope factor seems appropriate. I also agree with EPA's conclusion that the database for RDX provides "suggestive evidence of carcinogenic potential" by all routes of exposure.
